Take an excursion to Xi'an for a privately guided visit to see the famous Terra Cotta Warriors.


Chinese Cultural Entertainment

After lunch you fly to Chengdu, the capital of the Sichuan province in western China. This 2,400-year-old city is famous for its center for breeding Giant Pandas.
